Dear Gregory,

After careful analysis and consideration of KIOF-LP's FY 2017 Radio Community Service Grant (CSG) application, we regret to inform you that the station's application was not successful.

As stated in the application materials, CPB management has the responsibility to determine station eligibility and to decide whether a grant offer will be made to an applicant. CPB takes many factors into consideration when determining a new applicant's eligibility for the CSG program and stations are required to meet all of the requirements at the time of application.

Our analysis shows that KIOF-LP has not met all of the standards needed to qualify for the CPB CSG program at this time. Specifically, KIOF-LP is not eligible for a CSG because it does not meet the required Non-Federal Financial Support minimum of \$300,000, has no Full-Time Employees, and does not meet the Audience Service Criteria.

You are welcome to reapply in any future application window once you are able to meet eligibility requirements for entry into the CSG program.
